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General Cook Off Rules

General Rules:

1. El Campo Lost Lagoon reserves the right to expand or modify these rules and regulations. Decisions of El Campo Lost Lagoon management will be final.
2. All written or posted rules of the resort (in addition to these rules) will apply. It is each team member's responsibility to read and understand the rules.
3. El Campo Lost Lagoon is not responsible for theft or damage to equipment or contestants.
4. The Chief Cook is responsible for the actions of its team members and guests. Excessive use of alcoholic beverages will be grounds for disqualification and expulsion from the resort grounds. No alcoholic beverages are to be served to anyone under 21 or sold to the public. All alcohol must remain in cook-off participants designated area. **TABC regulations strictly prohibit any alcohol from being taken into the gated pool areas or any buildings. Private alcohol is only allowed at the RV sites. Alcohol is available for onsite purchase and consumption inside the bar areas.**
5. Each team will be given 4 pool area entry wristbands for Friday and Saturday night per site. Up to 4 additional wristbands can be purchased per RV site for \$20 each.) Teams requiring more than 8 wristbands must purchase an additional site on the registration form. No additional guests will be allowed on resort grounds without a wristband. No day passes will be allowed. Registered cooking teams/families and RV guests only.

6. Music will not be tolerated after 10PM on Friday or Saturday night. **Excessive or profane music will not be allowed anytime!** Please be courteous to your neighbors and observe all noise rules and regulations.
7. No cooking equipment or vehicles will be allowed on grassy areas unless prior direct approval by EL Campo Lost Lagoon is granted under each case. No parking trailers or vehicles in the roadways.
8. Each team will be allowed to bring a golf cart (**no UTV's or ATV's**) to access the entry turn-in point and navigate the grounds in designated areas. Operators must be 21 years old or older and are asked to be considerate of other participating teams while utilizing these vehicles. Private golf carts require a \$10 permit each and acceptance of resort golf cart rules obtained upon check in. Resort golf carts will be available for rent for \$90-\$140 per day and can be reserved before check in. No unnecessary golf cart traffic or "joy riding" will be allowed after dark.
9. Each team is responsible for cleanup and placing trash in trash bags and placing it at the end of your RV site for pick-up and removal.
10. Each team is responsible for preventing grease and dripping on the concrete.
11. Please utilize a containment to prevent staining of concrete.
12. Children must be always supervised. No children under 12 will be allowed to enter the pool without supervision.
13. All teams must be cleared from their site no later than 11AM on November 20th.

Salsa: A 20 oz. foam will be provided. Fill the cup $\frac{3}{4}$ full. Judging will be based on taste, ingredients, aroma, and appearance. Judges will be provided Tortilla Chips for Tasting

Beans: A 20 oz. foam will be provided. Fill the cup $\frac{3}{4}$ full. Judging will be based on taste, ingredients, aroma, and appearance. Pinto beans. No Cook Off Association rules will apply for this cook off.

Chili: A 20 oz. foam will be provided. Fill the cup $\frac{3}{4}$ full. Judging will be based on taste, ingredients, aroma, and appearance. For the Purpose of this Chili Cook-Off, Chili is defined as ANY COMBINATION of ground, chopped or cubed meats together with spices and seasonings along with tomatoes, onions, peppers and liquid such as broth. Please no beans in your chili. Please use meats within good tastes. No Chili Cook Off Association rules will apply to this cook-off; only these rules apply.
